



AT FRENCH CONTEST 2013



Participants :

This contest is open to all 11 meters radio operators in three different categories.

Category 1 : French AT members (including overseas territories)

Category 2 : other Alfa Tango members

Category 3 : other radio operators

Operators from category 2 and 3 must only contact operators from category 1 during the contest.

Detailed rules for category 1 are available on the French AT website (www.alfatango-fr.org)

Duration 48 hours :

The contest is on weekends, each of 24 hours, starting on Saturday 12h00 UTC and finishing on Sunday 12h00 UTC

Modes and Frequencies :

The following modes are authorized : AM – FM – SSB.

The following frequencies are forbidden : .501 - 604.

It is authorized to call on usual frequencies and then QSY outside the forbidden frequencies.

Logs :

Logs can be computerized (Word, Excel) or handwritten.

The following information is compulsory for each contact :

Call sign, Multi (if the station is a multi operator), date, precise UTC, band or frequency, RS report.

Since 2012 progressive numbers are no more necessary.

QSLs :

QSLs are not necessary for this contest, only logs will be valid for the score. If however an operator wants a QSL card for a contact, he must then send a contribution. This rule is only valid during the contest.

Score :

Categories 2 and 3 : 1 point for each valid contact

Prizes :

In each category, one cup will be awarded every 10 logs received.

For category 2, prizes will be awarded at the AT world meeting following the contest or can be sent by post for postage cost.

For category 3, prizes will be announced on the French AT website and can then be claimed. Prizes will be sent for postage cost.
